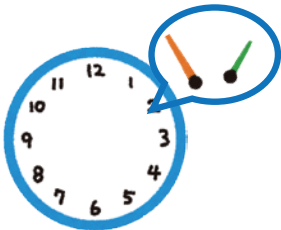
Teachers
